Players may purchase more than one entry and payment must be made in advance. **4.** All profits from the Lottery go to Age Concern Enterprises Limited, a wholly owned subsidiary of Age Concern England. **5.** The society may reject any application without giving reason at its absolute discretion. No detail in the application may be changed in any way once it has been submitted, except for a change of address. **6.** Prizes for the Age Concern Weekly Lottery are printed in this leaflet and on the Age Concern website. There are no alternatives to any prize and no interest is payable. Prizes will be sent by cheque within 14 days. **7.** The society reserves the right to use winners' names for promotional purposes.
