How to ask for in memory donations?

If you would like to arrange in memory donations, your Funeral Director can advise you on the wording for your newspaper announcement or the Order of Service.

For example:

‘Family flowers only. Donations instead of flowers if desired to ...’

or

‘No flowers please. Donations if desired to Age NI, 3 Lower Crescent, Belfast, BT7 1NR’.



Acknowledging donations

We work closely with your Funeral Director to acknowledge every gift made with a personal letter of thanks from us.

We will also send you a list of those people who have donated in memory of your loved one.
