Community Engagement

This is a paid-for service that offers nail cutting and basic foot care treatment by a trained foot health practitioner. The clinic operates from our Day Centre treatment room; we are unable to provide a home-visiting service. By appointment only.

Our Shed is a sociable and welcoming weekly group for older men and women who enjoy practical hobbies to work together and share skills on projects like furniture upcycling and repairs.

Gwynneth Morgan Day Centre

Our purpose-built Day Centre is for a mixed client group of older people, adults with disabilities, and adults with dementia. Experienced staff provide a range of activities, lunch and support from Monday to Friday, including transport to and from the centre. Facilities include an adapted gym, an accessible kitchen and a sensory garden. This service must be initially accessed via referral through Wandsworth Adult Social Care.

Age Well Together

Our Age Well Together Service offers Wandsworth residents a range of assistance at home to help maintain independence, prevent decline and reduce isolation. This includes support transitioning home after a stay in hospital, regular online shopping orders, and telephone calls and visits from befrienders. We can also offer practical help with jobs and adaptations in the home, including the supply and fitting of key safes and rails for falls prevention.
