Our Handyperson service carry out a wide range of light repair jobs around the home. You must provide materials required for us to complete the job.

Jobs that support home safety are **FREE** of charge. These include: changing lightbulbs; securing toilet seats; fixing loose carpet

Odd jobs are chargeable. These include: putting up shelves; repairing cupboards; light gardening (during the summer)
