



Homeshare accommodation in Oxfordshire – July 2025

Homeshare Oxfordshire carefully matches an older person, or couple, looking for help, companionship or reassurance at home, with another person who is happy to lend a hand. The Sharer gives the Householder up to 10 hours of their time each week as a combination of companionship and practical help, as agreed, and makes a monthly payment to Homeshare Oxfordshire of £200 pcm and an agreed contribution to the Householder towards bills.

Abingdon (ref 120)

Are you a caring and broadminded female, with a keen interest in the environment and society? We are looking for the right person who can provide gentle companionship, plus a bit of practical help, to a sociable, eco-conscious older person in a quiet area of Abingdon?

The Householder, in her eighties, has a scientific background and worked as a programme producer in the early days of BBC2. She retired from a career in education social work and voluntary work for a variety of charitable causes. She still has an active social life – going out for book club, coffees, cinema/theatre with friends. She has a love of classical music and used to sing in her church choir.

The Householder cares deeply about nature/wildlife, the wider environment, animal welfare, community and a caring society. She is an animal lover, especially cats! She is open minded and interested in exploring questions of faith and spirituality and regularly attends her local church.

Rising early, she may go out socially during the morning or afternoon but is home for her main meal of the day at lunchtime. When at home she enjoys reading, listening to music, watching TV especially nature programmes including Spring Watch and Countryfile and likes to be in bed by 11pm. In the warmer weather she enjoys potting on house plants and encouraging wildlife in the garden.

The Householder is looking for some gentle companionship at home eg sharing a meal, watching TV, low key chatting about each other's day and subjects of interest. A like-minded independent, younger person, keen to live in an eco-conscious way, a driver with their own car, able to help with the odd lift, would be ideal. A friendly cat would also be welcome!

She has a regular cleaner, gardener and IT support. The shared areas - bathroom, downstairs toilet, kitchen and garden would also be shared with a quiet, male lodger.

Are you kind, considerate and friendly person with a quiet lifestyle who could provide light companionship and a reassuring presence in the home to a friendly, interesting Householder in the peaceful village of Lower Shiplake, two miles from Henley and with excellent public transport links to London, Reading and Twyford?

The Householder, in her nineties, has spent much of her life living abroad and has extensive life experience of travelling the world. She is young hearted and remarkably fit for her age (a former golfer and still attending pilates classes) and loves her garden, looking after the birds and fish. She has a broad range of interests including painting, music, reading, crosswords and playing bridge and enjoys relaxing during the evenings and watching TV.

Whilst the Householder prides herself on her independence and would like someone who would be happy to live fairly independently too – for example, sometimes cooking and eating meals at separate

times – she recognises that a little support and light companionship would now be helpful. Someone who could help with a weekly shop, occasional trips and happy to have chats over a cup of tea, but who had their own interests and discreet lifestyle would be ideal. A reassuring overnight presence is an important factor. The Householder has close and supportive family living nearby and enjoys their regular visits.

This Homeshare opportunity would suit someone, preferably female, who is kind and helpful, prefers to live a quiet lifestyle mainly spending time at home in the evenings but with their own interests and independent life. A car driver would be essential. Because it is easier for family to visit over the weekend, it would be fine for the Sharer to be away at weekends.

The bedroom is slightly separate from the rest of the house, with its own bathroom and an attached dining room rarely used by the Householder day-to-day which could be used as a working space.
