



100 Club Rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. Money raised from the 100 Club will be paid into the Age UK Shropshire Telford & Wrekin bank account and used to help the charity to provide services which improve the quality of life for older people in the county.

Rules

- 1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100.
- 2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
- 3. The prizes will total 45% of the monthly income.
- 4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 25%, 2nd prize of 15% and 3rd prize of 5% (of total monthly income).
- 5. The 100 Club is a small society lottery and is open to all clients, supporters, volunteers and staff of Age UK Shropshire Telford & Wrekin. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
- 6. Numbers are limited to two per household.
- 7. Payments must be made by standing order (preferably annually) or annual cheque. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
- 8. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
- 10. The draw shall be made by a member of public on the 27th day of each month.
- 11. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
- 12. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the charity's website and social media accounts (unless the winners wish to remain anonymous).
- 13. The 100 Club will be run by Age UK Shropshire Telford & Wrekin. In case of any dispute the decision of the Chief Executive is final.
- 14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Age UK Shropshire Telford & Wrekin funds after six months.
