

2020-2021 Impact Report

Age UK Waltham Forest is an independent local, user-led charity supporting older people in the London Borough of Waltham Forest. In 2020-2021 our team of 16 part time staff and 444 volunteers supported 5,909 older people in our Borough through our range of Services.

We repurposed our organisation on 16th March 2020 to focus on supporting older people through Coronavirus. This meant we closed, adapted or postponed our regular activities; for example befriending became largely telephone, based during the first wave; as are information/advice and form filling sessions. Our Digital Inclusion Sessions, Book Club and a sample of our Exercises Classes are now delivered via Zoom.

Some of our existing funders agreed to suspend delivery or repurpose their funds and staff rose to the challenge to support older people during this time.

We had to adapt quickly and transform our organisation to a new way of working whilst seeing demand increase exponentially. Because we needed to support older people we immediately increased staff hours and therefore our wage bill. We also brought in additional staff and managed to get all staff working from home within a week which involved buying laptops, mobile phones and printers.

These extraordinary times called for an extraordinary response, we became a partner with the Local Authority's Community Help Network providing prescription deliveries and additional telephone befriending. We also developed a shopping service and provided emergency-essentials parcels (food and incontinence products) to those older people most in need.

We are members of the Age UK federation but are a totally independent charity, separate from the national body, and have to raise all our own funds for our work.

Our vision is to see an inclusive, respectful and supportive society in which each older person leads a good quality, enjoyable and fulfilled life, and in their later years is supported to live independently at home for as long as they wish.

We aim to promote and enhance the well-being and quality of life of all older people, especially at those points in life when the right help can make a significant difference.
