## **Regulations for Exhibitors**

1. All cut flowers to be exhibited in vases, cases or tubes containing water. All dishes for fruit or vegetables & vases etc are to be provided by the exhibitor. No wire or artificial support allowed above the container. Exhibitors entering an exhibit in any one class cannot use the same exhibit in any other class.
2. Judges shall have the power to exclude any exhibits that are deficient in number or merit. The decision of the judges is final except in such cases as mentioned in regulation 3.
3. All objections and complaints must be made to a member of the committee. The committee shall withhold any prize in dispute until the objection or complaint has been investigated by at least three members of the committee. Their decision is final.
4. All exhibits must be staged between 4pm—7.30pm on the Friday 29th Sept or between 8-10am on 30th September No late entries will be permitted.
5. No exhibits to be removed before 2.00 pm.
6. All entries must be made on the official forms available from Age UK or from Johnsons. Entries will not be accepted without the correct form. Forms to be submitted by the 15th September together with the appropriate fee (£1 per entry).
7. All exhibitors shall obtain a number on the day for each exhibit. They are then responsible for numbering their exhibits.
8. The committee reserves the right to cancel any class if the entries do not warrant it being undertaken.
9. All exhibitors must have cleared the hall by 10 am on the morning of the show, Judging commences at 11.00 am. Re-open at 12.30 for public viewing.
10. Trophies will be at 1.30 pm. Winners name and year will be engraved on the trophy. Winners will be required to give an undertaking to be responsible for the safe keeping & to return them before next show.
11. All exhibits remaining after 2.15 pm will be put forward with donated exhibits for auction in aid of the show funds which will start at 3pm.
