Introduction:

The service:

The main job role will be to assist in the café, taking orders for food, making and serving drinks and keeping the area clean and tidy at all times. Ideally you will have cafe/barista experience but full training will be given. Other duties will consist of setting up the café area and clearing up at the end of the day.

Role requirements:

- Excellent communication skills
- Flexibility with a team approach
- To occasionally assist with washing up in the kitchen
- A genuine interest in people and empathy with older people
- Ideally, although not essential, previous experience of working with people in a supportive/caring capacity



- A basic understanding of, and a willingness to learn about, keeping yourself and others safe while performing the role.
- May at times be required to have some direct client contact, such as meet & greet
