Royal Mail Stamp Swap Out Scheme



Do you have any old stamps?

Royal Mail have added barcodes to all their 'regular stamps'. Regular stamps without a barcode* will no longer be valid after **31 July 2023.** After that items sent with an 'everyday'

non-barcoded stamp will incur a surcharge. If you don't think you will be able to use up all your non-barcoded stamps before 31st July you can swap them for the new barcoded ones. *Any special stamps like the Christmas or picture ones are not affected.

You can get the 'Stamp Swap Out' form via the following methods:

Download and print off a form from the <u>Royal Mail website</u> You can also request a form by calling Royal Mail's customer services team on **03457 740740.** If you want to pick up a form in person you can pick one up from your local Royal Mail delivery office or Post Office.

Thank You to John Lewis Cheadle



We would like to say a big 'THANK YOU' to John Lewis in Cheadle who recently gave us a very generous donation of £1,000.

The donation will be used by our Hospital Discharge team at Stepping Hill Hospital, to support the most vulnerable people that are being discharged from hospital. It will be used to supply resources that facilitate a discharge such as bedding, kitchen equipment, warm clothing and oil filled radiators.

Our Hospital Discharge Team seek to support people

with what they need to ensure a timely and safe return home. This is vitally important for the wellbeing of the person who is ready to return home and also to relieve pressure on hospital beds for other people who may be waiting. Due to the cost-ofliving crisis some people find it hard to pay for basic resources and this can delay a discharge home. The team are therefore delighted to have these additional funds to offer this support.

If you or a loved one is in Stepping Hill Hospital, or have recently been discharged and would like to access this service please contact a member of your care team who can reach the Hospital Discharge Team on your behalf.

Two Campaign Wins

We're delighted to say that following a campaign from the Age UK network the <u>government has now announced</u> that the age for free prescriptions will not change and will remain frozen at **60**! This is a huge win for older people and a result of a significant coordinated effort across the Age UK Network.

This news will no doubt come as a relief especially in the middle of the cost of living crisis.

The other win is following a campaign from Which, that will ensure consumers can withdraw and deposit cash for free.

Measures to protect free access to cash have been unveiled by the government in an amendment to the Financial Services and Markets Bill.

The Bill will ensure people can continue to conveniently withdraw and deposit cash. This means the FCA will have greater power over major banks and building societies to ensure reasonable free access to cash is preserved for those that need it. You can read more about it here

Our team of friendly Support Workers are fully trained by Age UK Stockport and recruited from the local community.

Our team can assist with a range of activities including practical tasks at home, domestic support, companionship, leisure activities and supporting with hospital and other appointments

From July we will also have a new service - **Tandem Easy Shop ONLINE**.

A special service that offers support and assistance to ordering shopping on-line.

Easy shop ONLINE recognizes that some people do not have the available equipment or the technical knowledge to take advantage of the benefits of ordering shopping online and having it delivered by the supermarket to your door.

The service is delivered at a special rate where no home visit is required.

At **Step Out Stockport** we provide daytime service for adults at Whitehill Resource Centre in Reddish. This includes structured activities, support with personal care, moving & handling, medication & we cater for specific dietary requirements.

Whitehill is a safe and welcoming place, where people can attend for the day and enjoy meeting new friends and engage in a wide range of activities. We work closely with Adult Social Care, the Meadows & other agencies, as well as the members relatives to ensure that every member receives an outstanding quality service.

If anyone you know may be interested in this service, please share the information on our website <u>Age UK Stockport | Step Out Stockport</u> or we can post you a paper copy of our leaflet. We invite people to come and have a look round the centre in the first instance - this is by appointment only. To make an appointment please call 0161 480 0480. After a look around visit, we would invite the person to come for a taster session, where they would come for a couple of hours, so we could get to know one another a little more. During the taster visit an assessment will be carried out by a trained member of staff to observe the person's support needs.

Could you be Stockport's Banksy?!

A new street art initiative is starting in Stockport this summer and organisers are looking for people to try their hand at a spot of creating. No experience with spray paint necessary, just an open mind and willingness to try new things. Interested? Read on...

GRIT Studios is a creative makers space in central

Stockport which is home to an array of grafters and crafters, including willow weavers and stained-glass restorers.

Over the past 18 months, creatives have been engaging local residents and business owners in a huge clean-up operation, involving litter picks and paint and plant days. Their work has seen one of Stockport's dirtiest streets turn a corner, with planters and art installations appearing throughout.

Taking things up a gear, thanks to funding from **Arts Council England**, the studios now have plans to create a number of large-scale murals and art installations from outside their studio down to the top of the Underbanks. Brightening up the local area with their creative corridor and encouraging people to explore their local environment.

The project is keen to involve as many local people as possible from across the borough. Whether you're a seasoned professional or haven't picked up a paintbrush since school, everyone is welcome to come and create some community artworks.
