## The International Day of Older Persons



Every year we mark the United Nations International Day of Older People (IDOP) on 1 October. It is a day recognised by the UN as an opportunity to acknowledge and appreciate the extraordinary contributions and achievements of older people.

This year the theme in Greater Manchester is Celebrating the importance of neighbourhoods in ageing well. The key messages are;

- Older people's voices and contributions need to be valued so that neighbourhoods in Greater Manchester are good places for everyone to grow older.
- Our neighbourhoods are key to ageing well. At least 80 per cent of the time of those 70 and over is spent in the home and the surrounding area. We need to make sure our homes and communities are age-friendly.
- Our population is ageing rapidly, we all need to act to ensure places are accessible and welcoming to everyone we as age Join the Age Friendly Movement!

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# Offline and Overlooked Campaign



Age UK is currently campaigning to make sure everyone can access the services they need - so that being offline doesn't mean being overlooked.

Public services are rapidly 'going digital'. If like 2.7 million older people in the UK you aren't an internet user, it's becoming harder – and in some cases impossible – to access day-to-day necessities such as banking, making NHS appointments or even just paying for car parking.

But it's not just those who aren't online. Plenty of people would just prefer to handle their finances, their bills or their health matters in person or over the phone. No one should feel forced to perform important tasks online if they don't feel comfortable.

We would always encourage people to get online and are able to offer the support through our digital drop in's both at the Hub in Edgeley and Brinnington to enable people to do this, but we realise this isn't suitable for everyone.
