Dementia Friendly Garden Plans

2020 sees the launch of an exciting new project to design and create a Dementia Friendly Garden for the Step Out Service in Whitehill.

We aim to design a new green space embedding the importance of outdoor time for those living with dementia. Working with specialists we will ensure that the space is designed in a way that works not only for those living with dementia but also carers, family members and the local community. The planting scheme will be sensory and will invite insects, birds and other creatures into the garden. The garden will also encourage participation by the users with fruits trees, raised beds and a glasshouse / shed combo for growing from seed or potting on.

Changes to Travel Passes

From 1st February 2020 if you have a TfGM-issued pension-age concessionary pass or a Women's Concessionary Travel pass and you want to continue to benefit from unlimited off-peak travel on trams and trains in Greater Manchester you will need to pay an annual £10 fee.

There is no change to free, off-peak bus travel across England so if you only use buses, you can choose not to pay to add tram and train. Also the £10 charge does not apply to concessionary passes for disabled people.

The new scheme starts on 1st February but you will be able to pay early from 5 January, to make sure you're ready! You can pay in person at a TfGM Travelshop or at a PayPoint shop (from 25.1.20) or you can pay online at getmethere.com To buy online, you will need to link your concessionary pass to a get me there account and can find more details and a step-by-step guide at getmethere.com/add-a-card.
