Carers Week - 10th to 16th June 19

Carers Week is an annual campaign to raise awareness of caring, highlighting the challenges unpaid carers face and to recognise the contribution they make to families and communities throughout the UK. It also helps people who don't think of themselves as having caring responsibilities to identify as carers and access much-needed support.



There are 6.5 million people in the UK who are carers. They will be looking after a family member or friend who has a disability, mental or physical illness or who needs extra help as they grow older. Caring can be a hugely rewarding experience but carers often find it challenging to take care of their own wellbeing whilst caring. It impacts on all aspects of life from relationships and health to finances and work. Caring should not be underestimated, without the right information and support, it can be tough. We have an 'Advice for Carers' information





booklet which looks at both the practical and emotional side of caring. It aims to let you know where to go for help, so you don't feel you have to manage on your own. You can download a copy by clicking on the picture or you can collect one from our office in Merseyway or just give us a call!
