

### **Warm Homes Programme**

As we head into warmer weather you may not be aware that Age UK Stockport is already thinking about the support we can offer during the Winter months.

The Age UK Warm Homes programme has supported older people to stay warm and well during the cold months for over a decade. Age UK Stockport is proud to deliver this programme locally.

Our Handy Help Service carried out 500 home energy checks over the last 12 months.

Our trusted handypersons can visit your home to check how energy efficient it is. The handyperson can fit appropriate equipment to increase the energy efficiency. This includes things like:

- energy saving light bulbs
- draught excluders
- reflective radiator panels

The handyperson can also offer practical tips to help you keep your fuel bill down.

If eligible, this service is delivered at no cost as the programme is funded by energy suppliers to support the most vulnerable and fuel poor older individuals. Feedback from those receiving this support has again been overwhelmingly positive this year and we are hopeful the programme will be delivered again for the next 12 months.

### A Heartwarming Tribute to VE Day – 80 Years On



This May, Age UK Stockport proudly honoured the 80th anniversary of VE Day with not just one, but two unforgettable events filled with reflection, joy, and heartfelt connection.

On Thursday 8th May, our community came together at the Hub for a truly special celebration. The room was buzzing with nostalgia and warmth as we enjoyed classic tea and cake, accompanied by singalongs to beloved wartime tunes by Vera Lynn and others. But it was Alma's incredible wartime recollections that truly stole the show. Sharing her personal story of evacuation and childhood during WWII, Alma captivated the room. Her honesty and courage brought the past to life, and we are deeply thankful for the privilege of hearing her story.

The celebration continued into Friday 9th May, where several of our clients were invited by Sky Cares to an afternoon tea like no other.
