### Make Care Fair Petition – Act now!

You may remember last month we highlighted the Make Care Fair petition, asking the Prime Minister to fix the care system for good. Because of the budget on 11th March, Age UK would like to make the public's strength of feeling clear to the Government in advance of any announcement.

The best thing to do if you have questions or concerns is to phone 111 to get information from the NHS.

We currently have a number of events organised which at the time of going to press we are going to hold, <u>but</u> we will be reviewing all events on a daily bases and act in accordance with National Guidelines

#### Do I need to avoid public places?

Most people can continue to go to work, school and other public places.

You only need to stay away from public places (self-isolate) if advised to by the 111 online coronavirus service or a medical professional.

#### How to avoid catching or spreading coronavirus

**Do -** wash your hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds, always wash your hands when you get home or into work, use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available, cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze, put used tissues in the bin straight away and wash your hands afterwards and try to avoid close contact with people who are unwell.

**Don't** - do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean.

Do not go to a GP surgery, pharmacy or hospital. Call <u>111</u> if you need to speak to someone.

# **Are You Eligible for Pension Credit?**

The Government are currently running a campaign to raise awareness of Pension Credit and challenge some common misconceptions by highlighting that:

- people of State Pension age may be entitled to Pension Credit even though you may have savings or a retirement income or own your own home
- an award of Pension Credit can provide access to a range of other benefits such as help with housing costs, council tax or heating bills

Also a change in circumstances can make someone newly eligible for Pension Credit (for example, bereavement, a change in health or disability). So even if you've applied before and did not get it, it may be worth another look.

If you are happy using the internet there is a Pension Credit Calculator to find out how much Pension Credit you may be entitled to – without giving any personal details <a href="https://www.gov.uk/pension-credit-calculator">https://www.gov.uk/pension-credit-calculator</a> Or you can contact The Pension Service on 0800 99 1234.

Or you can contact the Information and Advice office on 0161 477 1213 or email advice@ageukstockport.org.uk and they can do a benefits check for you.
