'We Are Undefeatable'

'We Are Undefeatable' is a national campaign to support the 15 million people who live with one or more long-term health conditions in England. It aims to help those with conditions such as diabetes, cancer, arthritis and Parkinson's to build physical activity into their lives. It has been launched to inspire, reassure and support people to be active by showing people living with a variety of conditions – both visible and invisible – on their own journeys to being active. Watch out for the adverts!

One in four people in England live with a long-term health condition, and individuals in this group are twice as likely to be inactive despite evidence that being active can help manage many conditions and help reduce the impact and severity of some symptoms. Even small amounts of activity can make a significant difference to overall health and wellbeing.
