What is a COGs Club?

The club is modelled on Cognitive Stimulation Therapy (CST). CST is a programme of structured activity sessions for small groups of people experiencing memory problems. The club provides a range of stimulating and enjoyable activities as well as the opportunity to interact socially, have fun and make new friends.

COGs clubs provide support, guidance and optimism to local older people who have memory problems. For their carers the clubs provide the opportunity to have a break and some time to themselves.

The Tuesday COGs is Age UK Dacorum's fourth club to open. It will run from 10 a.m.-3 p.m. every Tuesday. Please ring 01442 259049 for more information.

Age UK Dacorum is a local charity supporting older people and their carers in the community by offering a range of services including Active Living Clubs, Befriending & Telephone, Carers' Support, Counselling, Friendship Teas, Handyperson Scheme, Information & Signposting and Memory Support Services.

Why should I attend?
