The Patients' Representative Service offers support, representation, advocacy and information to older patients and their carers whilst at Lings Bar Hospital.

We can help if

You need extra support during your hospital stay or regarding your discharge home. If so, please contact our Patients' Representative (see overleaf).

We can provide independent support for patients and their carers. At some time, we all need support and representation, someone to be our voice. We all need someone who will listen.

What the service provides

The Patients' Representative may be able to help if:

- You are worried about an aspect of your hospital stay
- · You want someone independent to speak on your behalf
- You need support during a time of crisis
- You have a difficult decision to make
- If you need general information or possible access to other services
- You require follow up support when you have been discharged home
- If you are worried or concerned, talk to us we are here to help

What extra support do we offer?

- Information on financial matters and benefits
- Information on health and social care
- Details on services available in the community once discharged. For example community outreach, visiting and other support services
- Assistance in referring and signposting to any appropriate services


