

Coach Trip Betws-y-Coed

Thursday 14th August 2025

Betws-y-Coed is North Wales' most popular inland resort, it is where the River Conwy meets it's three tributaries flowing from the West, Afon Llugwy, the Afon Lledr and the Afon Machno.

Much of it was built in Victorian times and is the principal village of the Snowdonia National Park. The main street, Holyhead Road, has numerous inns, shops, craft shops with the popular Swallow Falls. At the railway station is a Museum with a miniature railway and the old 14th century church of St Michael's is one of the oldest in Wales and is worth viewing
