

**Digital Champion Volunteers** 

Why this matters: 25% of people aged 65 and over don't use the internet, because of a lack of skills, trust or equipment. Older people without digital skills risk losing access to services such as banking, and health services, as well as tools that keep people connected.

**Vision:** We're passionate about local older people understanding the benefits of being online and supporting their engagement with IT, to build confidence and maximise opportunities to engage with an increasing digital world.

## Location:

At venues and homes across the county, or remotely via telephone or online

Time requirement:
2-3 hours per week to fit around your existing commitments.

Role summary: Digital Champions motivate and inspire older people to get online, providing one-to-one and group IT training to develop digital skills and confidence. This enables people to engage safely and securely in the digital world. Working as part of a team, support may be one off or regular and ongoing and in a variety of settings, including in peoples' homes, community groups or online, depending on the needs of individuals.

Your role: Our volunteers tell us that they gain an enormous satisfaction and a real buzz helping people build on their developing skills and navigate the digital world. Volunteering as a Digital Champion provides the opportunity to develop and use coaching and mentoring skills whilst making a real difference to the lives of older people. It's also a great way to make new friends!

## **Requirements:**

- Communication skills to relay information in a clear, accessible and personable way
- Reliability and empathy to create a safe space for older people with different levels of knowledge and skills to develop and test their digital skills

- Confident digital skills using a range of devices (smart phones, tablets and laptops).
- An enhanced DBS check and completion of training, both in person and online
