
These diagrams are designed as an indication only. There are certain types of income and capital that may be ignored, or partially ignored for example:

- Disability benefits such as AA, DLA and PIP are ignored as income
- The value of the home you live in is ignored as capital


There are also circumstances that can boost your eligibility, such as living alone when getting a disability benefit.

Benefits calculators such as <u>benefitscheck.ageuk.org.uk</u> are specifically designed to work through these things to give you an answer regarding your eligibility but if you feel your circumstances are more complex, you may prefer to seek one-to-one advice.

Single person - reached State Pension age BEFORE 06/04/2016




Single person - reached State Pension age AFTER 06/04/2016




Total weekly income
