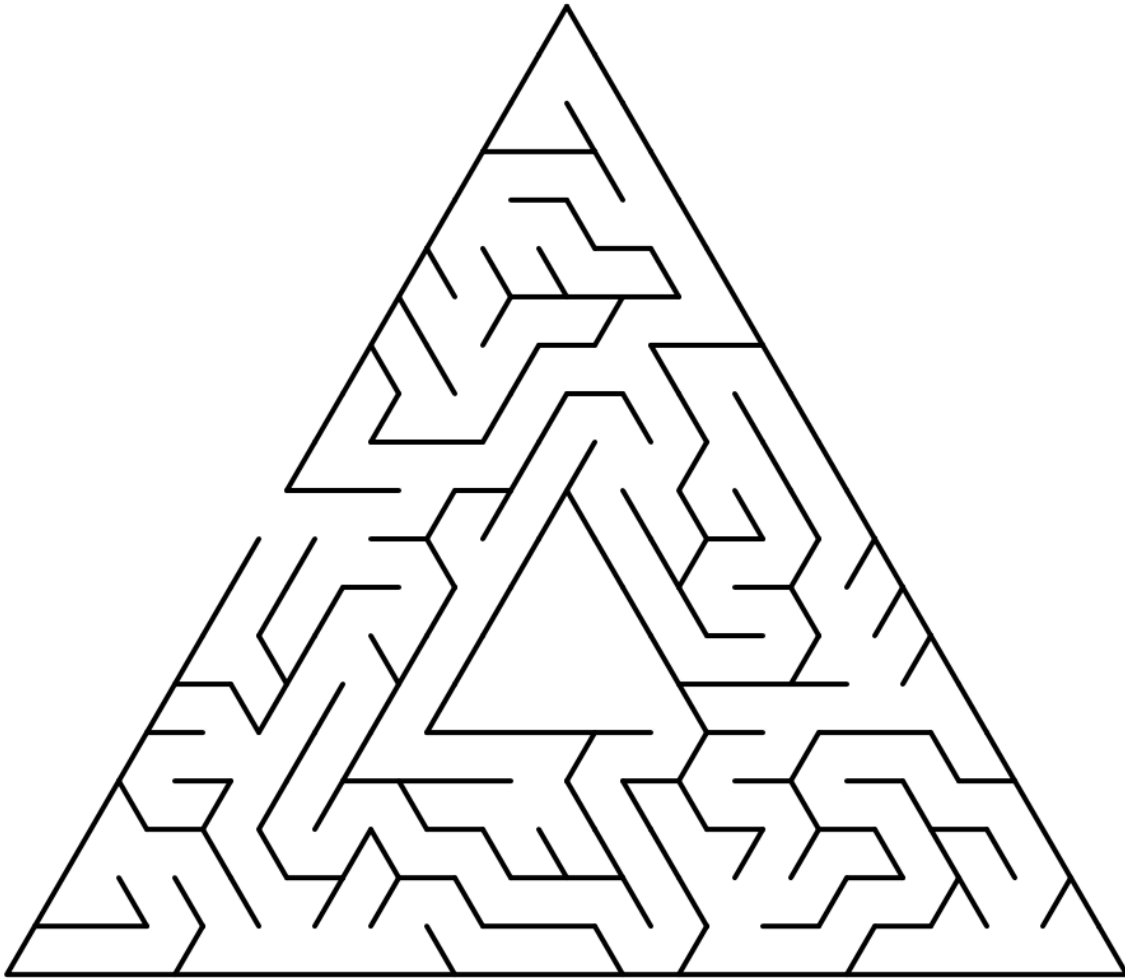

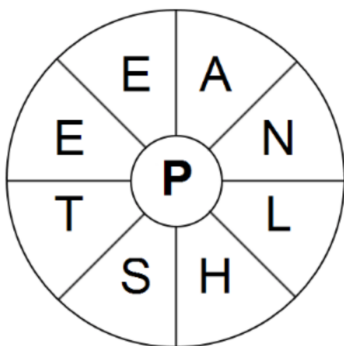

Let us possess one world, each hath one, and is one.

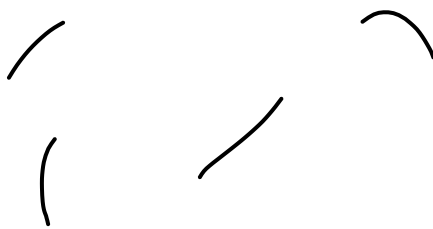
My face in thine eye, thine in mine appears,
