The group always meets at the **Hollies** in front of Sainsbury's at **10.00am** on the **First and Third Wednesday** of the month. All our walks are locally based and vary between 2.5 and 3.5 miles.

3 July	Hollies, Gullock Tynning, path, (Town Park), Radstock Rd, High Street**
17 July	Silver Str, Nature Reserve, railway path, down to Withies **
7 August	Withies park, up to railway, left to Nature Reserve & back
21 August	Underhill Rd, right on field, right to Langleys Lane and back via Hayes Park** (uneven surface & stile)
4 September	High Street, Radstock rd, path to Gullock Tynning **
18 September	Riverside, across Chilcompton rd, thru field and right down Folly Hill, Redfield and Island**
2 October	High Street, Station Rd, left on cycle path to Northmead rd, Hayes park, Vivien Av, Clevedon rd, Northway**
16 October	Silver st, Charlton rd, Nightingale way, Longfellow, Pitt path
6 November	Island, Redfield rd, Clapton Rd and back**
20 November	Tesco, Paulton, Welton**
4 December	Midsomer Norton Cycle path circle
18 December	Charlton Park & Nightingale Road
1 January 2020	Northway, Clevedon rd, Vivien Av, Hayes park, Northmead, cycle path to Station rd and High street
15 January	Midsomer Norton, Westfield Industrial Estate
5 February	Riverside walk
19 February	Underhill lane out & back
4 March	Excelsior rd, Pit rd, cycle path left, cross Radstock rd, right to Radstock and back
18 March	Clapton Road**
1 April	Midsomer Norton Cycle Path circle
15 April	Silver Street Nature Reserve**
6 May	Island, Redfield, right on Woodside, right on Underhill, Hayes rd, Vivien, Clevedon, North rd, South view place
20 May	Folly Hill circle (or Clapton Rd)
