

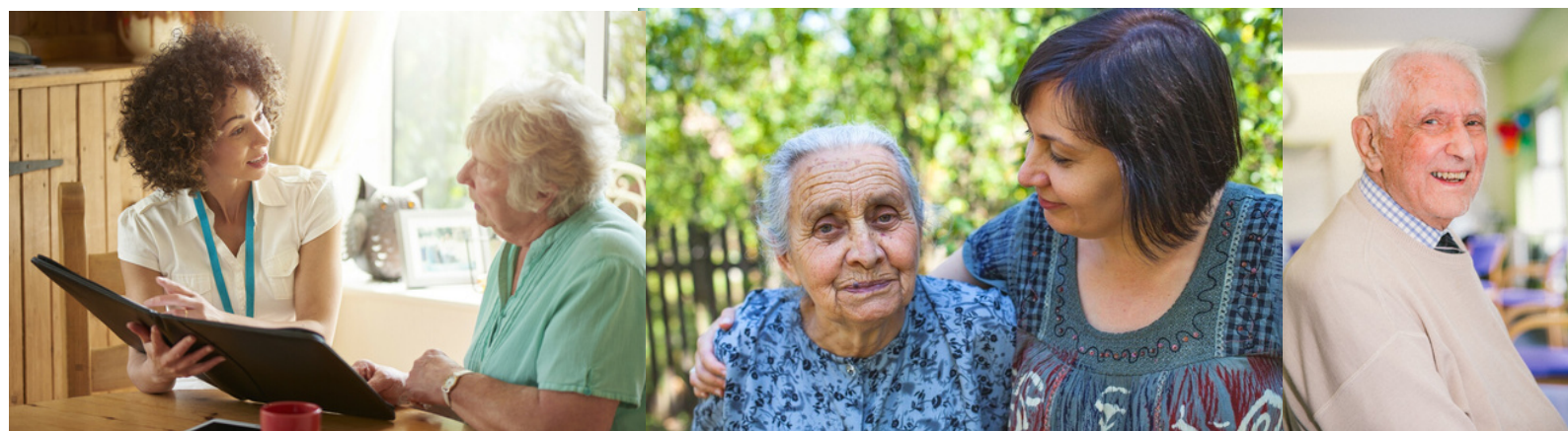

How Age UK Barnet helps older residents

We are reaching out to all older people in the borough who need our help and here are some of our main services and activities...

✓ We offer information and advice on crucial issues affecting older people including benefits, care options, and housing so that older people in Barnet can make informed decisions for themselves.



Our advice team has dealt with over 3,000 calls, letters and emails over the last year

✓ Our Handyperson team carries out small jobs around the home to help people stay safe

✓ Our Shopping service supports those struggling to get out to the shops.



Why support us?

Our mission is, quite simply, to help improve the lives of older people in Barnet. In Barnet, more than 60,000 people are over the age of 55. It is estimated that more than 10 per cent of those live in poverty, and that the number of over 65s living with a life limiting condition will increase by 50 per cent by 2035.

Loneliness, isolation and poverty in later life is something that most people don't want to think about and often believe won't happen to them, but these issues really can affect anyone and everyone, no matter where they live...

What's in it for you?

Fundraising and volunteering is a great way to motivate staff and provide a common focus, or goal for your organisation. Supporting a local charity such as Age UK Barnet not only provides a positive impact to local older people but is also extremely rewarding for the volunteers too. Research by NCVO, has shown strong links between volunteering and improved health and wellbeing for volunteers.

Ways you can help us

Choose Age UK Barnet as your chosen 'Charity of the Year'

This gives endless opportunities to fundraise. You can ask different teams to compete to see who can raise the most money over a period of time.

Gifts in kind... products or services that may otherwise cost us money.

This can include gifting the use of function rooms, providing refreshments or food for an event or paying for the design or printing of leaflets or other merchandise. Or maybe you could offer us some training or put on a one-off workshop for the older people we support. You could also donate a product or service for us to use at a raffle, or as a prize.

Sponsor an event

You could support us by sponsoring an event or purchasing publicity materials, which would then have your company logo featured. Our regular events include a charity golf day, carol concert, quiz nights and music performances.

Come to us with an idea for a fundraising event and we'll work out how we can support you, whether it's a ball, a music fundraiser, a staff dress-up day or sponsored silence.

Sponsor our newsletter or Pigeon Post magazine

An opportunity to have your logo on our newsletter or Pigeon Post magazine, which is delivered to over 1,250 Barnet residents who are not online.

Match Funding Many employers operate a Match Funding Scheme whereby any fundraising donations that are made by individual employees are matched by the employer. This means double the donation!

Corporate volunteering opportunities - a few ideas to engage your teams!

- 1: Leaflet distribution to reach out to older people who may need our services.
- 2: Sponsored events or challenges like running the marathon for us.
- 3: Volunteer for an activity or event or, for a longer term involvement, become a shopping or befriending volunteer or help people get to grips with their computer, tablet or phone.
- 4: Bucket collections
