# **Energy Efficiency Volunteer**

Responsible to: Independence at Home Manager Time Commitment: 1-2 days a week, 4 hours each day

Location: Visiting clients' homes across Birmingham & Sandwell

## **About the Service**

Our Warm Homes programme is a funded service for older people who are finding it difficult to keep their homes warm and therefore are at risk of cold related illness. Exposure to cold can have a devastating impact on health. Our service provides clients with awareness of how to save energy whilst staying warm and well, and to see if they could benefit from any energy efficient equipment. The project runs from September – March each year.

## **About the Role**

As an Energy Efficiency Volunteer Officer, you will be supporting the Warm Homes Programme, a seasonal project which is part our Independence at Home Support. In this role, you will:

- To undertake Age UK Birmingham and Age UK Sandwell induction programme and additional relevant training where required
- Receive referrals from Independence at Home manager
- Conduct home visits to vulnerable clients to provide advice on staying warm during winter months
- Instal equipment, such as lightbulbs, draft excluders, insulating foam, radiator foil panels
- To keep accurate and confidential records
- To report any concerns to the manager of the service
- Signpost clients to relevant Age UK Birmingham services
- To attend team meetings/ supervision when required

Travel expenses will be reimbursed in accordance with HMRC guidance
