Home Falls Prevention Volunteer

Responsible to:	Independence at Home Manager
Time Commitment:	1-2 days a week, 4 hours each day
Location:	Visiting clients' homes across Birmingham

About the Service

Age UK Birmingham's Home Falls Prevention team provides older people with services to stay confident and mobile within their own home. We are looking for a reliable volunteer that is confident and has experience with DIY tasks, to support this service to help older people in Birmingham make the most of later life.

About the Role

The Home Falls Prevention Support Volunteer will visit clients to advise on minimizing falls within their home. This will also help with their mobility, confidence and increase wellbeing. In this role, you will:

- To undertake Age UK Birmingham and Age UK Sandwell induction programme and additional relevant training where required
- Receive referrals from Independence at Home manager
- Conduct home visits to vulnerable clients to provide a falls prevention assessment
- Instal equipment, such as lightbulbs, grab rails, stair rails, and key safes
- To keep accurate and confidential records
- To report any concerns to the manager of the service
- Signpost clients to relevant Age UK Birmingham services
- To attend team meetings/ supervision when required

Travel expenses will be reimbursed in accordance with HMRC guidance

- DIY experience
- Good listening and communication skills
- Patience and tact

- A caring, sympathetic, sensitive manner and a non-judgemental approach.
