Our Home Falls Prevention Service supports older people to reduce the risks of a fall at home by fitting equipment and making small changes around the house.

What kind of jobs do we do?

Our Falls Prevention Officer will visit you at home to discuss safety in your house and the changes you would like to make to increase your confidence and safety at home.

We can:

- Fit a key safe
- Move & assemble furniture
- · Carry out small household repairs
- Fix toilet seats
- Complete small carpentry jobs
- Fit grab and stair rails

- Carry out security checks
- · Change light bulbs
- Secure loose carpets/rugs
- · Provide non-slip bath mats
- Free Energy Checks (draught proofing and energy saving equipment)

Eligibility criteria applies and some maintenance jobs are excluded. Work is carried out to reduce the risk of falls.
