Advice and Information

We know that the cost of living crisis is hitting many people hard at the moment, with huge energy bills and the rapidly rising costs of food in the shops. If you are a pensioner, please ensure that you have spoken to our Advice and Information Offices to check your entitlements. We have seen an increase in people accessing the service by over 40% and many were pleasantly surprised to find out that they could claim additional income or entitlements. Don't ever rule your self out because your neighbour or friend couldn't claim anything as everyone's situation is different. Details of where to find us are in the poster to the side.



Household Support Scheme

The new Household Support scheme launched on 30th May to provide help for BwD residents with energy bills, white goods and food. If you are struggling to manage your finances please get in touch with our Advice and Information Offices



Digital Help

Did you know that we offer support to help you to learn how to use your mobile phone, tablet or laptop. We can help you to learn just one thing such as grocery shopping online, how to WhatsApp or message on social media. We can help with setting up an email, showing you how to access GP records and order prescriptions and give you the basics

of online banking.

Launch of new Wayfinder Dementia Support service

At the beginning of May we launched our new Wayfinder service. Funded by the national Lottery Community Fund this free service offers support to anyone aged 50 or over living in Blackburn with Darwen who has been diagnosed with dementia or their carers.

Our trained staff are at the end of the phone to help navigate the dementia journey offering a listening ear as well as information about local support and activities, access to benefits, help to navigate the care system as needed and also advice about future planning. You can self-refer to the service by contacting our switchboard.

Memory Makers

If your memory is not what it used to be, or you have a diagnosis of early stage dementia then our specialised Memory Maker Session can help to maintain muscle memory and improve social confidence. Using specialised cognitive stimulation therapy our small group sessions offer activities, quizzes and discussion on current and local affairs.

Sessions take place in Darwen at Darwen Town Hall on Thursday mornings and also at Accrington Road Community Centre on Tuesday mornings and cost £5

There is a an initial up front charge of £7.50 for your own personal nail care set and a charge of £15.50 per appointment (prices are subject to change). Unfortunately, we cannot accept people who have some medical conditions such as rheumatoid arthritis or on certain medications.
