Guidance Notes

Eligibility to be a trustee

You cannot act as a trustee if you are disqualified under the Charities Act. This includes if you:

- are disqualified as a company director
- have an unspent conviction for an offence involving dishonesty or deception (such as fraud)
- are an undischarged bankrupt (or subject to sequestration in Scotland), or have a current composition or arrangement including an individual voluntary arrangement (IVA) with your creditors
- have been removed as a trustee of any charity by the commission (or the court) because of misconduct or mismanagement.

In addition to meet 'Fit and Proper' requirements by HMRC you cannot be a trustee with the organization if you have been involved in tax fraud.

Criminal Convictions

We will require you to disclose information regarding **all** "unspent" convictions for **all** voluntary posts within our organisation. For some voluntary roles that bring volunteers into direct contact with vulnerable adults you will be required to disclose **any convictions, cautions, reprimands or final warnings** which would not be filtered in line with current guidance.

The amendments to the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 (Exceptions) Order 1975 (2013 and 2020) provides that when applying for certain jobs and activities, certain convictions and cautions are considered 'protected'. This means that they do not need to be disclosed to your place of volunteering, and if they are disclosed, the organisation cannot take them into account.

If your application to become a trustee is successful, and it is applicable to your role, you may be asked, under legislation for the Safeguarding of Children and Vulnerable Adults to agree to an enhanced check being made by the Disclosure & Barring Service about the existence and content of a criminal record. For other applicable roles you may be asked to agree to a Basic Disclosure being carried out about the existence of unspent convictions.

Please do not record details of criminal convictions on this application form. You will be provided with a separate form, together with guidance notes.

You should also note that a criminal record will not necessarily debar you from being a trustee with our organisation. However if it is discovered, at a later date, that you failed to declare information this may result in the termination of your role.
