

Virtual Tours

‘We may be stuck indoors for the time being but that doesn't mean we can't broaden our horizons beyond our living room walls. While we aren't able to physically travel the globe at the moment, there are ways to do it virtually – and for free’

- Open your internet e.g. Google
 - Type: www.moneysavingexpert.com/deals/deals-hunter/2020/03/free-virtual-globe-trotting/
Into the search bar at the top of the screen and press enter button on keyboard.
 - The page is set out into 6 different sections
1. Virtual museum tours
 - Click on the blue underlined title of the museum you want to look at.
 - This will open a new web page
 - This may give you 2 options - the virtual tour has opened automatically or you may have to click to choose which room you would like to look at.
 - Once you are viewing the room there will be control panels on the screen either at the bottom/ top, left/right.
 - Click these arrows to look up/down and around you.
 - There will also be a + sign to click to zoom in or a - sign to click to zoom back out.
 - Use the arrows on the floor of the picture to move across into a different room.
 2. World wonders and popular tourist sites
 - Click on the blue underlined title of the museum you want to look at.
 - This will open a new web page
 - Click on the picture and keep it held down whilst you move the mouse around to move around the screen to view.
 3. Fun and extreme experiences
 - Click on the blue underline title of the experience you want to look at.
 - This will open a new webpage.
 - All are youtube videos so will play automatically in the webpage.
 - To make the screen bigger press the symbol in the bottom right hand corner.
 4. Live streams of wildlife
 - Click on the blue underlined title of the wildlife you want to look at.
 - This will open a new webpage.
 - On the new web page will be a few options of animals that they live stream.
 - Click on picture of the animal camera you want to view
 - This will go onto a new page - scroll down the page and press play right in the centre of the picture.

5. Visit theme parks and go on rides

- Click on the blue underlined title of what you would like to look at.
- This will open a new webpage
- If you are looking at 'disney parks' this will bring up a picture that you then hover the arrow over- an arrow will now appear in the picture, click on the arrow and it will move you around the scene of the disney parks.
- 'Virtual disney' is a collection of videos - scroll through the page and when you want to view click on the picture and this will start to play.
- 'Seaworld' Click down on the picture and drag the mouse around to view the scene. Where there are circles with names this means you can click on them to view inside.

6. Theatre, ballet and opera

- Click on the blue underlined title of what you would like to watch.
- This will open a new webpage.
- On the new page click in the middle of the picture on the play symbol.
- To make the screen bigger click the symbol in the bottom right hand corner.
