Your Community Hubs

Age UK Bradford District have six Community Hubs, each one offering a range of functions – Information, Help and Support, Advice and Activities, focusing on the needs identified by local older people and working with the skills and resources from Bradford's diverse neighbourhoods and communities to support older people. They still provide places to have a good shop too!



The Community Hubs serve the following communities:

- Bradford East
- Ø Bradford South
- Ø Bradford West
- ✓ Keighley and Ilkley
- Shipley and Bingley

The six Community Hubs are based in Allerton, Idle, Keighley, Queensbury, Shipley and Wrose (see page 8 for details).

In each Community Hub you can access the full range of our programmes more locally and responsively than we have been able to provide previously.

Everyone is welcome at the Community Hubs, so if you're in the area please pop in, say hello and check out how we may be able to help you or someone you care for.


Each area has a Community Development Coordinator who is responsible for engaging with communities and building Age UK Bradford District's offer across the area, developing over time.

How we can help you



We have talked to older people across Bradford District about what makes a good life. They said it was family and friendship, health, finance, home and community.

Older people told us, we listened, and we have acted to make sure that Age UK Bradford District is all about working with you to connect people to the information, help and support, advice and activities that older people need to live their best life through a range of programmes.



Information

- Lifestyle Connections: providing information points to connect you to the information you need to have choice and control in your life and community
- 1:1 connections: providing a listening ear and someone to have a quick chat with in all our hubs
- Home Connections: repairs and maintenance by trusted traders, gardening services, home adaptations and cleaning
- Community Connections: linking you to activities and events in your community

Help and Support

- 1:1 Connections: one to one support, confidence building and friendship
- Digital Connections: sharing and developing IT skills and knowledge
- Community Connections: linking your skills, interests and abilities with people who need them through volunteering opportunities, community buddies and neighbourhood champions and ensuring that your voice is heard by those making decisions that affect your community

Advice and Casework

Lifestyle Connections: connecting you to the advice and casework support you need to make decisions about your life and to help you to be legally and financially secure

Activities

- Active Connections: helping you to keep fit and healthy
- Creative Connections: learning and sharing skills and interests
- Social Connections: social groups and events run by you, with you and for you

Whether you're an Individual Buddy or a Team (Corporate) Buddy, we would love you to join us. Simply decide what you are able to contribute and join our Buddy Scheme by going online at ageuk.org.uk/bradforddistrict or email info@ageukbd.org.uk.

- £2/month enables us to support 10 older people with Telephone Buddies
- £3/month enables us to support 3 older people with Home Buddies
- £5/month enables us to deliver an additional activity session for an average of 10 older people
- £10/month enables us to fund and support engagement with 6 older people who are in crisis
- £20/month enables us to recruit and train a new volunteer who will provide support to 30 older people on an ongoing basis

- £50 enables us to support 20 older people with Telephone Buddies
- £100 enables us to support 10 older people with Home Buddies
- £200 enables us to provide casework and representation services for an older person by engaging with them in their own home
- £250 enables us to recruit and train 1 new volunteer who will provide support to 30 older people on an ongoing basis
- £500 enables us to fund and support engagement with 25 older people who are in crisis
