- Signposting to other local and specialist support organisations (including the Dementia Wellbeing Service)

- Support from a Coordinator who will ensure that our service is built around your needs and who will deal with any questions or concerns
- All of our volunteers are carefully selected for the role and are trained, supported and are DBS checked
