


What's Happening - In Brief

A Note from Amanda Allen (CEO of Age UK BRWF) - January 2024

- It seems as though 2024 has started as 2023 ended, with a lot going on and a high demand for our support and services!
- As part of its 'Spread the Warmth' campaign (which is calling for support to help older people get through the colder months) the national Age UK team published its latest research focusing on the health and wellbeing of older people. The report reveals the challenges being faced by older people across a range of topics, including cost of living (91% of those taking part reported that

they were worried about the cost-of-living increases), access to NHS and social care services, plus caring for others. For the first time the team have extended their polling to include people aged 50-59 and they have been struck by how much some members of this age group are struggling. IT, Systems & Comms Programme

With ageing and slow performing PC & Comms equipment across the charity, 'known -headwinds-of-2025' (including Microsoft's withdrawal of support for

Remote Desktop affecting our current Portal, Microsoft ending its support for Windows 10 and BT switching off its analogue networks for digital) along with increasing cyber security threats, last year the Board approved a 3 Year Programme to review our IT, Systems & Comms to help ensure that we have solutions that support, rather than 'constrains', the delivery of charity's business plans and aims, and its people have the 'tools' they need to perform their roles

- A key part of this programme was completed last year with all key Age UK BRWF locations having their broadband service upgraded to digital and their comms equipment replaced where needed
- The beginning of February will see the first phase of the introduction of our new IT Infrastructure, with our Retail Team receiving new PC's, access to a new 'not-timerestricted' Portal (providing a central point for accessing Systems & Apps, a Knowledge Base plus access to Quick Starts & Training information) and a new Retail SharePoint site (to replace the current Y Drive), all supported by improved IT security. Following Retail's implementation, we will then look to plan the migration to the rest of the organisation to the new IT Infrastructure, so watch this space!
