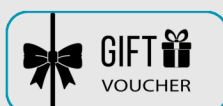

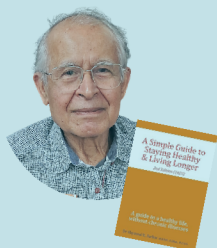
THANK YOU DR SARKAR

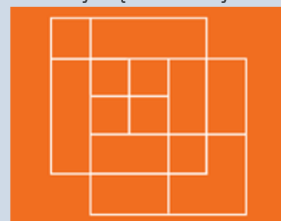
So Hot !
