Everybody welcome both children and adults.




JUBILEE CAFE 5* AWARD

Sunday 7th September at 3pm

On Sunday 7th September at 3pm the UK government will be carrying out a national test of the *Emergency Alerts* system which provides warning and advice in a life threatening emergency.

Reasons you might get an alert - Extreme storms, Severe flooding, Wildfires... There are simple and effective steps you can take to be more prepared for an emergency in your area. Visit gov.uk/prepare for more information.

What happens when you get an emergency alert?

Your mobile phone or tablet may:

- · make a loud siren-like sound (even if it's set on silent)
- ·vibrate
- · read out the alert

The sound and vibration will last for about 10 seconds. An alert will include a phone number or a link to the GOV.UK website for more information. You will get alerts based on your current location - not where you live or work.


FRAUD AWARENESS EVENT

They will be there to highlight and make people aware of the latest scams and how to protect yourself and others.




