
HAND MADE GREETING CARDS

We are receiving reports of people being contacted by phone call or by text message regarding the winter fuel payment. **This is a Scam!**

Scammers are offering to help setup the winter fuel payment and asking people for their bank details.

Never give out any personal information. A genuine organisation will never ask you for these details over the phone, text message, in an email or in writing.

The government has said you do not need to do anything.

Payments will be made automatically. No one will contact you directly.




