THE RETURN OF WINTER FUEL PAYMENT

Government Announcement

A national campaign pressing the Government has been successful and it has restored the winter fuel payment.



On 9th June 2025, the Government announced that they are reinstating the Winter Fuel Payment for everyone over the State Pension age in England and Wales. Anyone with an income of, or below, £35,000 a year will get the Winter Fuel Payment this winter.

The payment of £200 per household, or £300 per household (where there is someone over the age of 80), will be made automatically to help with heating bills this winter.

You do not need to do anything! Just regularly check your fuel statement.


SCAM ALERT

Scammers are offering to help setup the winter fuel payment and asking pensioners for their bank details.





Please pass on this information to others.

This will likely happen frequently now the winter fuel payment has been reinstated. Please exercise caution.

The government has said you do not need to do anything. Payments will be made automatically. No one will contact your directly.

TAXI VOUCHER ISSUES

Voucher Refusal



We have had reports of some taxi drivers from various companies not accepting local council approved vouchers as payment.

Drivers must accept these vouchers.

Please do not be forced to use a different payment method.

If you happen to experience any difficulties or even refusal then note down the driver's taxi licence number and route, and report it to the relevant taxi company.

BUS TRAVEL IN GREATER MANCHESTER

TfGM - Older People's Concessionary Pass - August Pilot

Starting on Friday 1st August, the pre - 9.30am travel restriction will be lifted on a trial basis for a month.

BEE NETWORK

As well as free early morning travel, it will mean older and disabled people with concessionary passes will be able to board the Bee Network's night buses, all night, for free for the first time.

The Transport for Greater Manchester (TfGM) will gather data on the demand to see if a permanent change is possible.

What you need to know:

- Available from 1st 31st August
- Valid for TfGM issued older person's or disabled person's travel passes only
- Available on Bee Network buses (please note: the trial does not apply across tram and train).



There is a high demand for our phone service. We are committed to staying in touch with those who are confined to their homes, manage independently, or simply want a kind voice on the other end of the phone.

June especially has been a very busy month for the KIT Befriending Telephone Service. On average we receive around 3 new referrals a month, but we received an astounding 12 up 75% with 66% of these calls being to Male clients.
