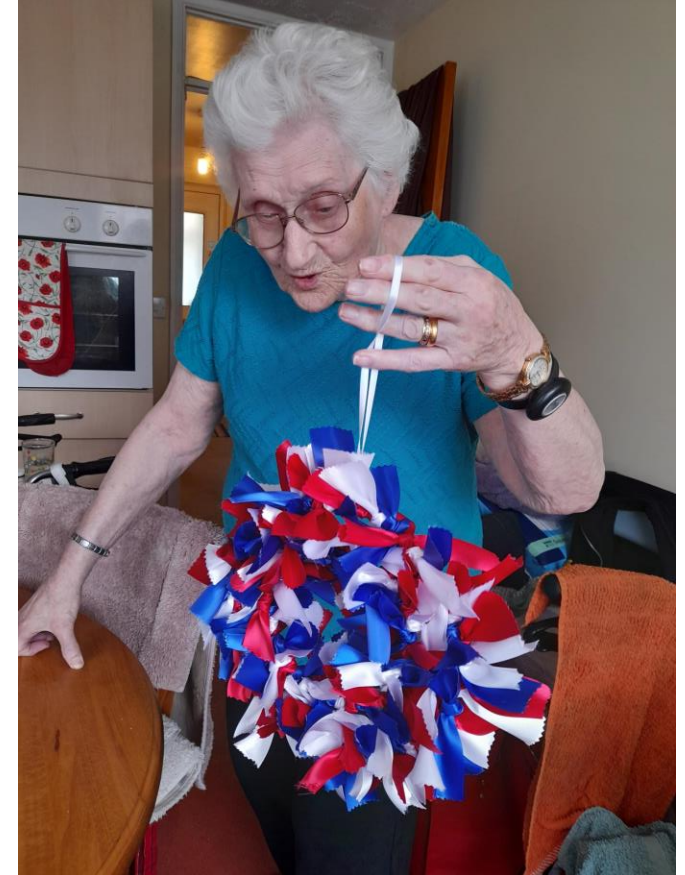
# Coronation Wreath Gift

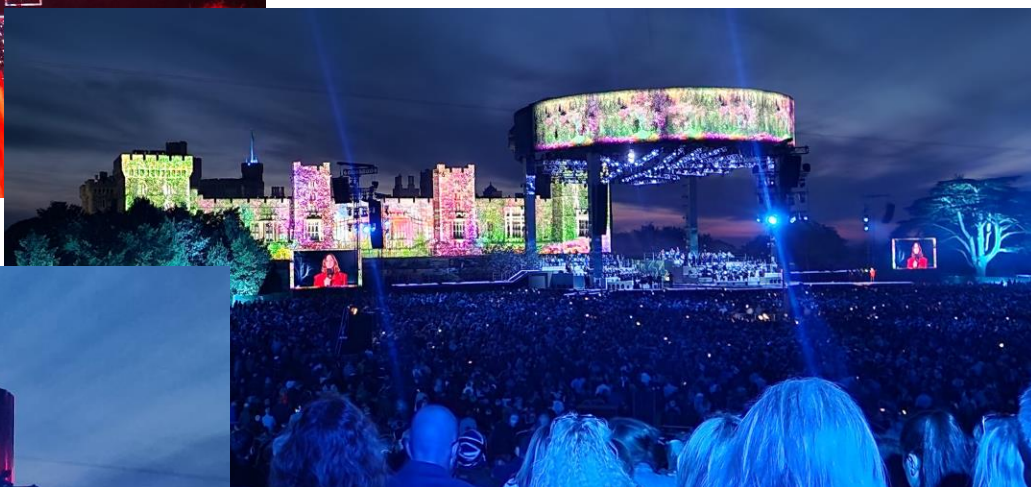

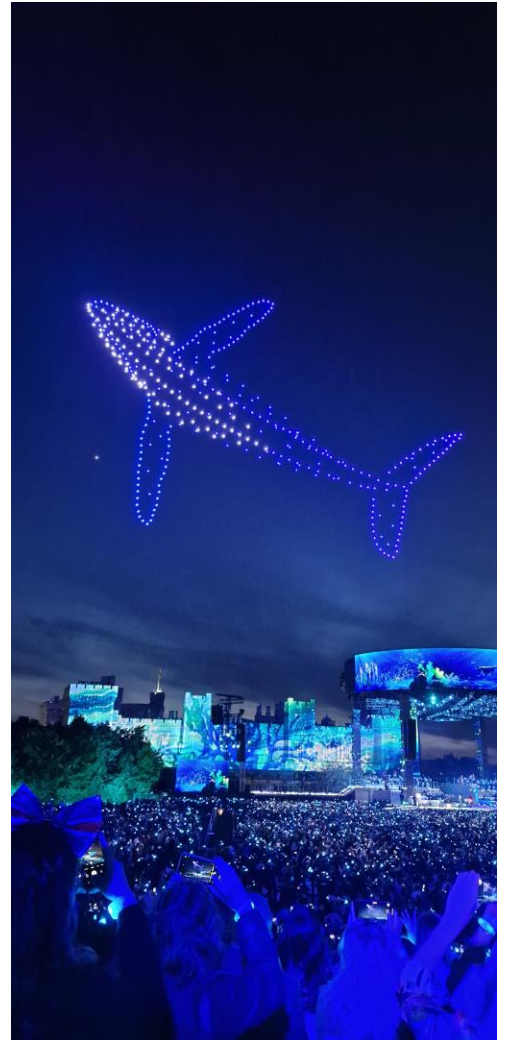
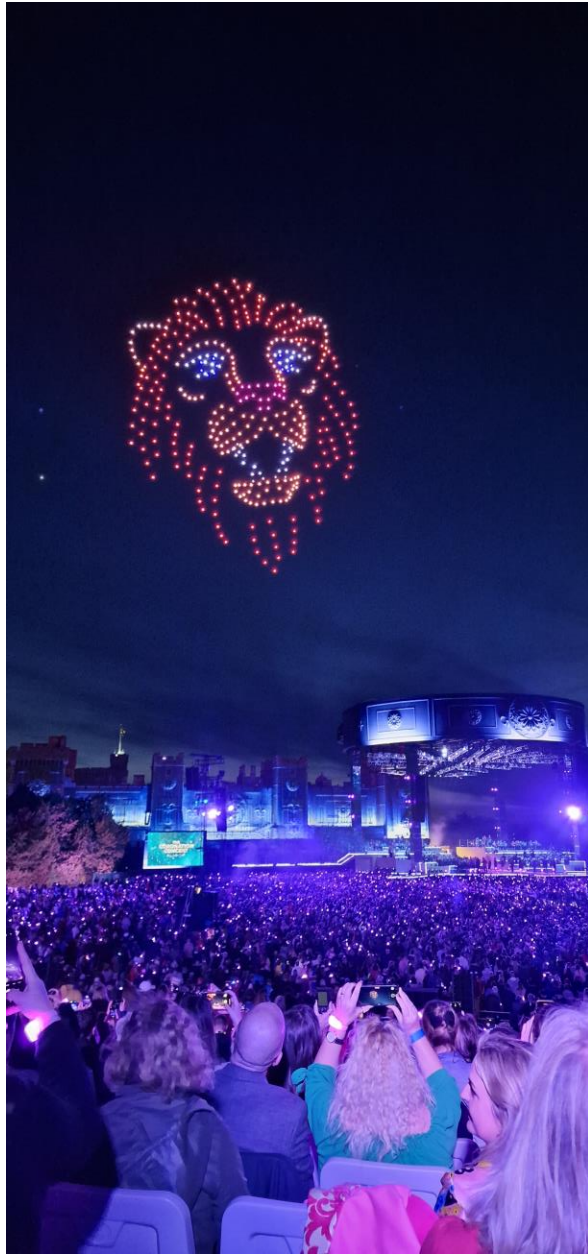
