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
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Girton Older Residents' Co-ordinator



The Older Residents' Co-ordinator works alongside statutory, voluntary and community groups in the South Cambridgeshire village of Girton to support existing groups, link residents with appropriate services, identify gaps in provision and where possible develop new groups, encourage socialising to increase health and well-being.

The Co-ordinator helps support and implement community groups and events such as exercise classes, afternoon teas and group walks to enable older people to make and retain friendships, feel part of their community and enabling the best quality of life.
