

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Information Services



Information & Advice

We provide free information so older people and their carers can make informed decisions on matters such as: benefits, housing, care choices, health and guidance on completing forms and applications. We have a range of useful free fact sheets and guides.

Visiting Support Service for Older People

We can give extra support when most needed; particularly when experiencing a difficult period, such as bereavement, ill health, financial or housing concerns, negotiating complex statutory situations.

Girton Older Residents' Co-ordinator

We work alongside statutory, voluntary and community groups in Girton to support existing groups, linking residents with appropriate services.



Social Opportunities

We provide opportunities to socialise, make friends and receive support.



Day Services and Friendship Clubs

Our services and clubs offer an opportunity for older people to socialise, enjoy activities, entertainment and have a meal.

Sharing Time and Telephone Befriending

Our trained volunteers offer weekly friendship and support, sharing time with an older person to reduce feelings of loneliness and social isolation.

Practical Support



We offer a range of support so that an older person can feel happier in their own home, stay safe and remain independent.

Cambridgeshire Handyperson and Home Checks

We aim to prevent falls and accidents in the home. We carry out Wellbeing Checks and provide equipment and adaptations to lessen the risks. We also enable people to be discharged from hospital at the right time with correct adaptations made to their home.

Community Wardens

Assistance to remain living at home independently by providing reassuring daily contact (Mon-Fri) and support with small practical tasks.

Home Support

Help with household tasks such as cleaning, laundry, ironing and shopping.

Hospital Discharge and Hospital Admission Avoidance Support

Wrap-around holistic service to support safe hospital discharges home and/or prevent a hospital admission/readmission.
