**The Community Warden Service** is managed by Age UK Cambridgeshire and Peterborough and is open to local people aged 60 and over. The service assists all older people to continue to live independently at home by providing daily contact (Monday to Friday) and support, either by a personal visit or telephone call, to ensure your sense of security and wellbeing.

## What can we help you with?

- Listening to your concerns and linking you to helpful information and guidance
- Advice on other local community services
- Small items of shopping
- Collecting prescriptions
- Reading post
- Making phone calls on your behalf, if requested
- Ensuring your safety and wellbeing

**Funding:** The service is funded by various local agreements.

**Free Trial:** You will be entitled to a two week free trial, however after the trial period, we do charge a small fee for our service which is payable to the warden.

A warden will provide you with daily contact giving you peace of mind and support for independent living, this can be ongoing or short term support depending upon what you need. It is important to note that the warden is not a domestic, home help or a carer providing physical care.

The Community Warden is employed and paid by Age UK Cambridgeshire and Peterborough and must not undertake tasks for you on a privately arranged basis.
