

How to leave a gift in your will

There are 3 types of gifts:

If you already have a will and you want to include a gift to Age UK Camden, you can simply ask a qualified professional such as a solicitor to add an amendment (called a codicil). If the change is more significant or complex you should make a new will.

It's important that you speak to a qualified professional such as a solicitor, when making or amending your will.

As a local, independent charity we raise our own funds and rely on the financial support of individuals, trusts, businesses and others to continue our vital work.

Residuary - a share of your estate after family and friends have been taken care of and taxes and debts have been paid

Pecuniary - a fixed sum of money

Specific - an item, eg a painting, or stocks and shares, or a gift of property
