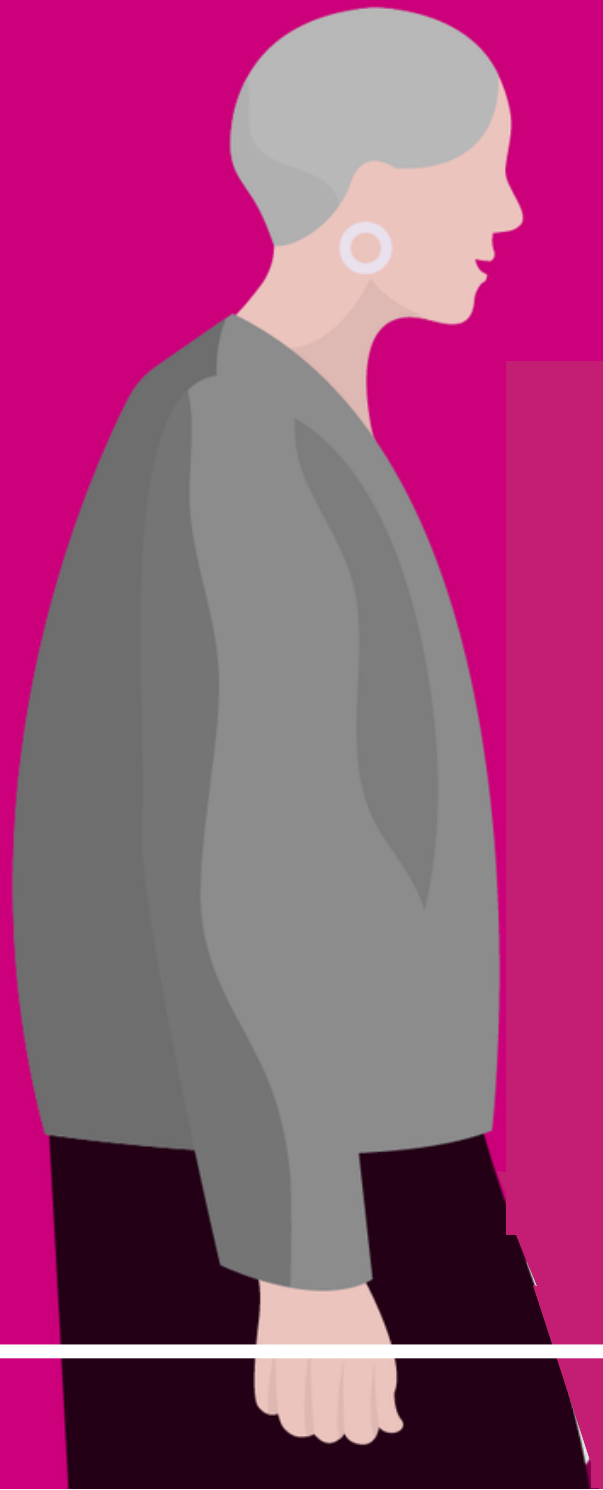






# How To Download NHS App

1.  For Android users it is a very similar process however, you need to go to the store which you usually get apps from e.g play store.

Click on 'App Store' as shown by the orange circle in the picture to the left.

2.  Click on 'Search' in the bottom right hand corner. Then type 'NHS' into the search bar at the top.

3.  Click on 'NHS App, Then click on 'GET' to download the app onto your phone.

4.  Wait for it to download then it should appear with your other apps.

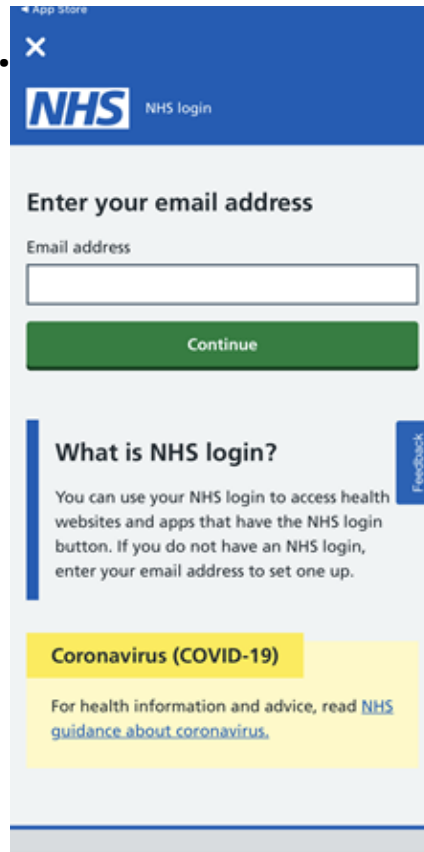
# Signing up to the NHS App

1. Click on your NHS App and this screen will be loaded.



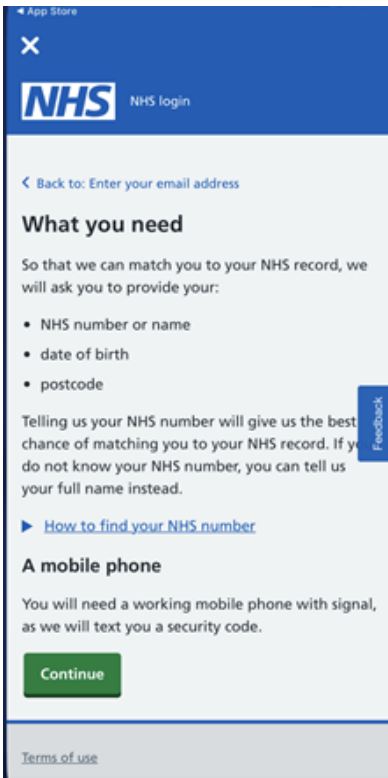
Next click on 'Continue with NHS login'.

2. Next enter your email address and click on 'Continue'.

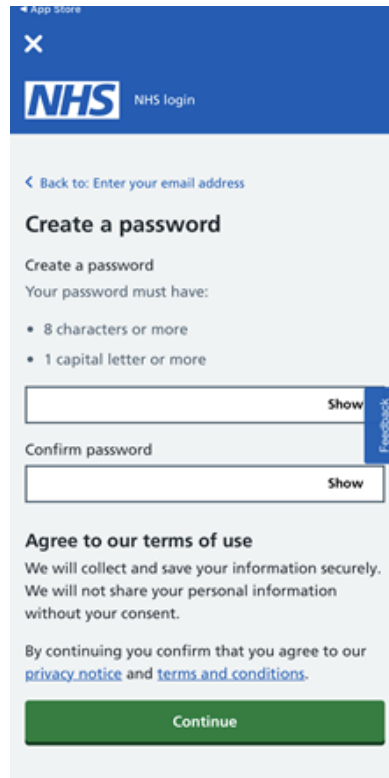


Another screen will appear and click on 'Continue' again.

3. Read through the instructions given and when ready click 'Continue'.

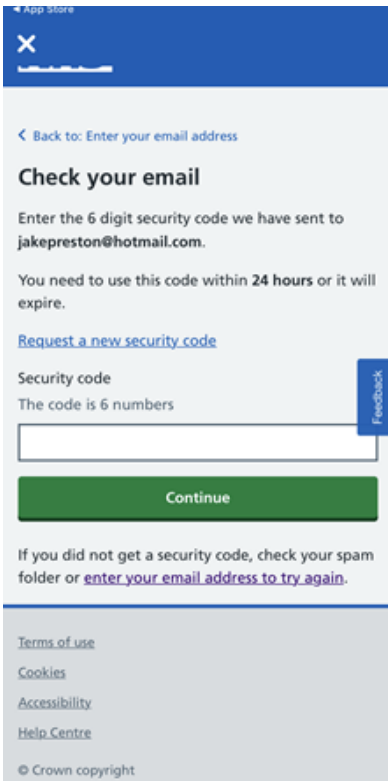


4. Now you need to create a safe password. Try using a combination of upper and lower case letters as well as numbers.



Once you have chosen one click on 'Continue'.

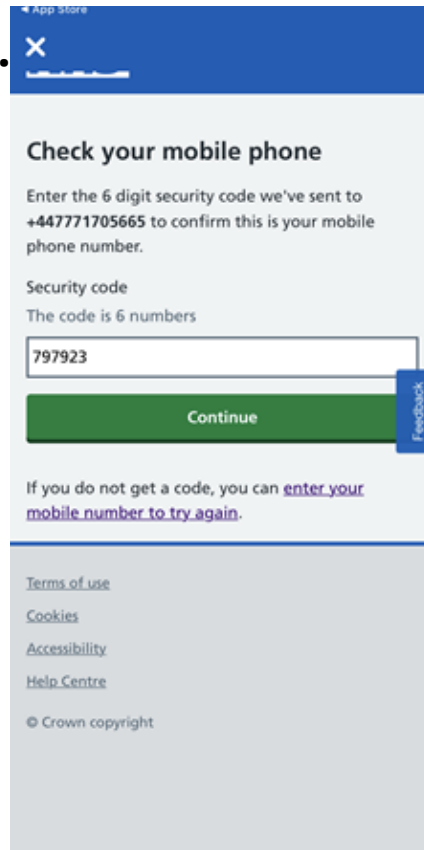

The app has now sent a security code to your email address. Open up your emails and note down the 6 digit code.

Return to the NHS App and enter the 6 digit code and click 'Continue'.

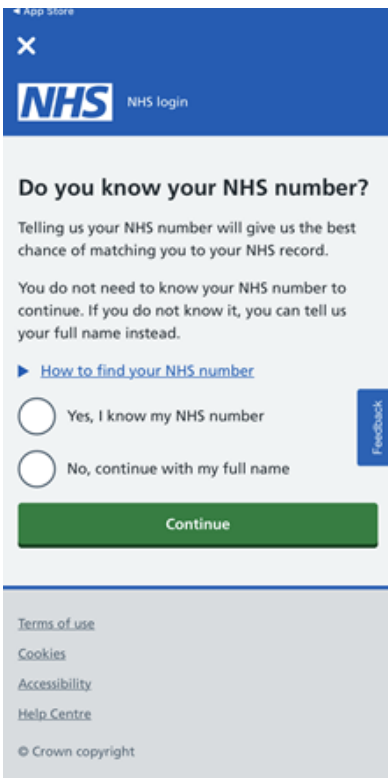

Next enter your mobile number and you will be sent another security code.

Once you have received this code via text message enter this into the app and click 'Continue'.

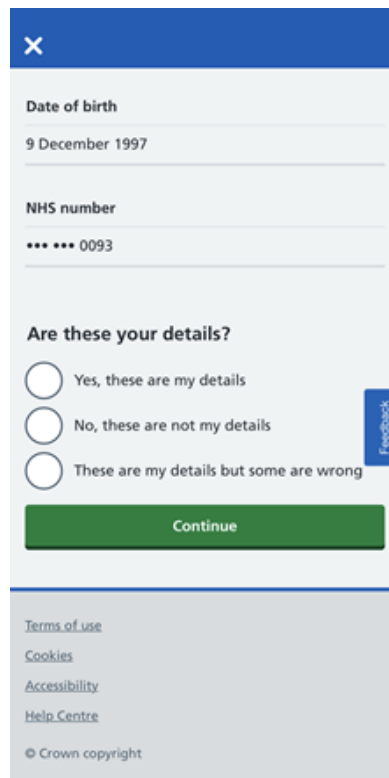

If you know your NHS number select 'Yes' and enter it. If you do not know your NHS number select 'No' and enter your full name.

Next click 'Continue'.

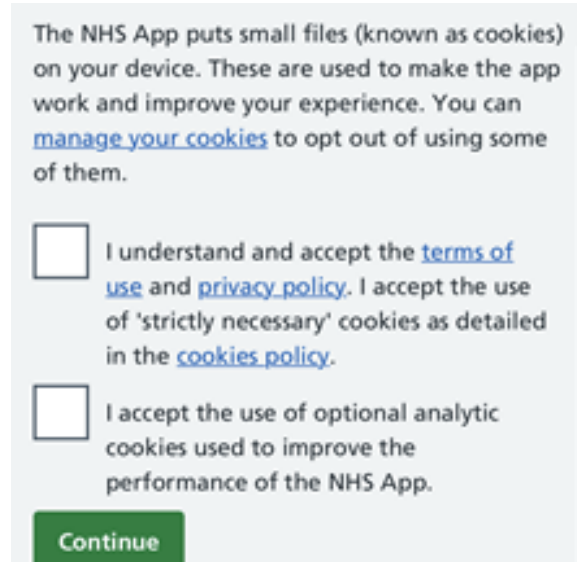
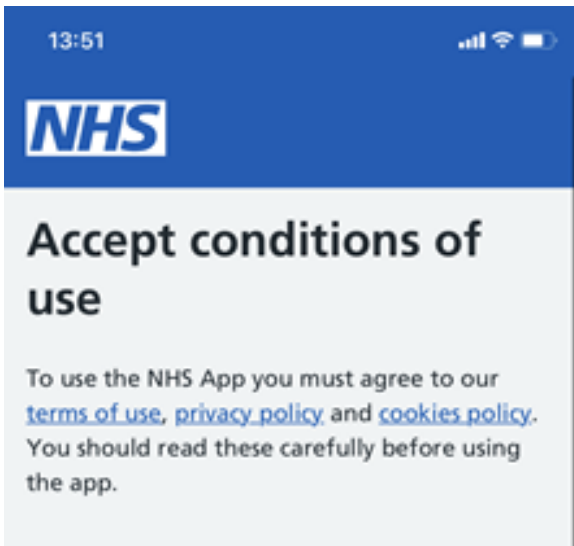

You now have to enter your date of birth and postcode. Check that the details are correct and select 'Yes' if they are then click 'Continue'.

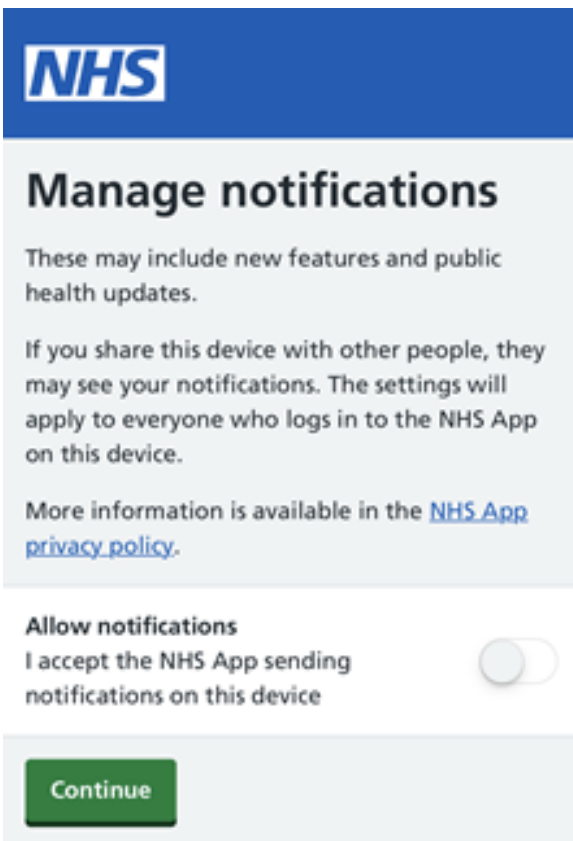
If they are not correct select 'No' and you can go back and change them.

Next you will be asked if the app can use details from your GP to prove you are who you say you are. Click 'Yes' then click 'Continue'. Next you need to read the conditions of use. Select that you have read and understood them then click 'Continue'.



If you want to receive notifications press on the switch next to 'Allow notifications', then press 'Continue'. If you don't want to receive notifications just press 'Continue'.





# Download your 'Domestic' Passport

1.  After you have logged into the NHS App this screen will appear.

2.  Then click 'Agree' on the next screen. Now click on 'Continue'.


To download your vaccine passport click 'Get your NHS COVID Pass'.

3.  Next you will be asked whether you want to view your 'domestic' or 'travel aboard' passport. For anything within the UK select 'domestic'. Anything outside the UK select 'travel aboard'.

4.  Your passport is now available for you to use within the UK when requested to be shown.


For now click 'domestic'.

# Download your 'Abroad' Passport



Click on 'Get your NHS COVID pass' and this screen will appear.


You want to select the 'travelling abroad' option, so click on 'Verify your identify now' then select 'Continue'.

Read the instructions on this next screen and then select 'Choose the ID you want to use'.

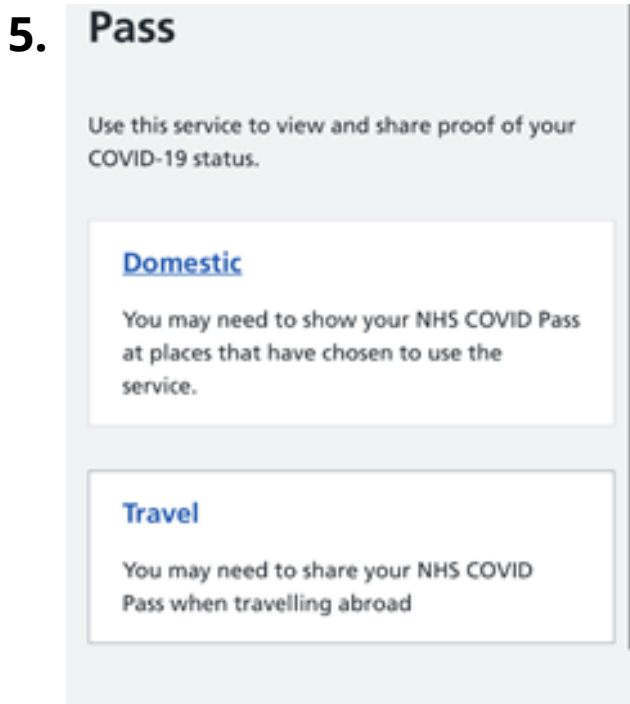
3. 

Next select which forms of ID you wish to use to prove who you are. Then select 'Continue'.

4. 

If you have a photo of your passport on your device already click on 'upload a photo'. If not, click on 'take a photo now'.

This will ask you to open your camera and enable you to take a photo of yourself.



Once your ID has been verified you will be taken back to your NHS home screen. Click on 'Get your NHS COVID Pass' and select 'Travel'.



You will then be taken to your COVID vaccine passport barcode for travel use outside of the UK.
