Information & Advice



This free service provides support to older people, their carers and families on a wide range of later life issues. We can advise on benefits and money, social care, housing options, and local services and support.

Keep in Touch telephone befriending



We link older people who may not get the opportunity for a regular friendly chat with one of our telephone volunteers. You'll receive a weekly telephone call at a time that suits you, to chat about anything you like!

Help at Home



Our home helps deal with a wide range of household tasks, maintaining your independence and keeping you living at home for longer. You choose the tasks we do. There is a charge for this service.

Support for people living with dementia



Our Dementia Day Club (charge applies) operates in Macclesfield every Monday to Wednesday. Our virtual New Horizons Club circulates activity packs for carers and offers online Zoom sessions for those cared for.

Scams Awareness & Aftercare



We help prevent older people falling victim to a wide range of scams and doorstep crime. As well as our monthly bulletins about current scams, we work with older victims of scammers, to help them get back on their feet.
