Things to consider when looking for love online

- How do they look on their profile picture? Professional photos with supermodel looks could be a red flag.
- Avoid giving away too many personal details when dating online. Revealing your full name, date of birth and home address may lead to your identity being stolen.



Is it "love at first sight" for your prospective partner? Beware those who want to get too close, too quickly.

■ Do you know who they really are – have you met their friends, family, work colleagues?

Are you being asked for money to help out with some emergency - lost passport, relative in danger, even expensive treatment for an illness. All of these have been used to con people out of money.

You can always do a bit of sleuthing if it all sounds too good to be true.

Question them and ask for facts that you can verify.

Finally

Never send or receive money or give away your bank details to someone you've only met online, no matter how much you trust them or believe their story.
