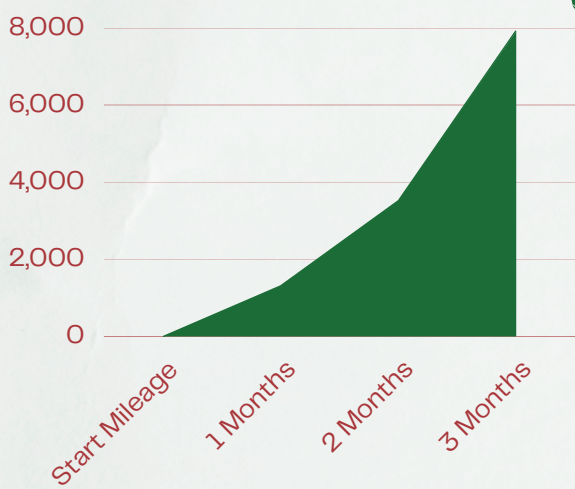


# Sustainable Transport Project | Cornwall 2023

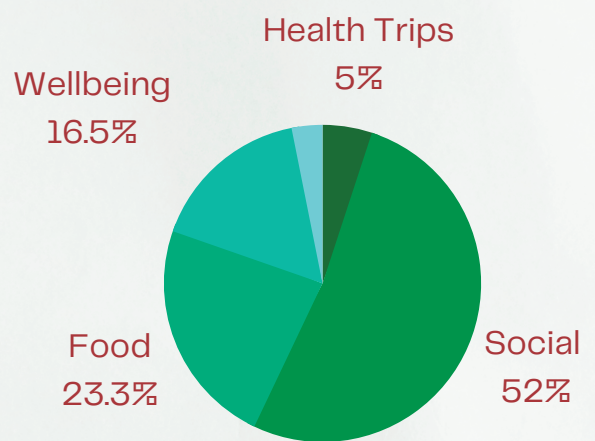
## YOU MATTER

From April 23 to July 23, our 7 Electric Vehicles completed **1,943 trips** and **transported 2,911 people**. This service supported health appts, clubs & activities at community hubs, social trips, wellbeing visits and memory groups across Cornwall.

### A range of support

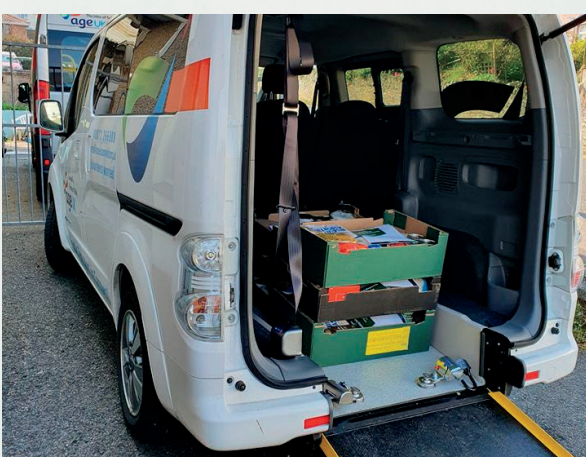
**1011** Social outings and **452** meal/shopping deliveries account for **75%** of total journeys. Increasing connections throughout Cornwall

## What we do

We have **7** Electric Vehicles and **8** designated Charge Points in **Penzance, Camborne, Truro, Falmouth, Newquay, St Austell and Lanivet**. They are based in community hubs and GP surgeries. They provide fully accessible, low-cost, environmentally-friendly transport for local groups, hubs & individuals.
