15 years and still going strong!

On the 10th October 2017 we celebrated **15 years** of delivering transport services throughout Cornwall & South Devon.

We held a small celebration in our Transport office and want to take this opportunity to formally thank our **amazing volunteers, staff & service users** that continue to make TAP a success.

The transport team **always go above and beyond** what is expected from them, and the amount of **support we provide** to isolated individuals in Cornwall, Devon & The Isles of Scilly is inspiring. None of this would be possible without our **fantastic volunteer drivers** who provide safe, coordinated, friendly, cost effective transport for everyone in the community.

In the **last 2 years** TAP have completed **206,463 journeys** covering **4,644,090 miles**. That is enough to go to the moon and back nearly 10 times!



What is TAP ?

Transport is an **essential requirement for people** in Cornwall, especially as we are primarily a rural community. Transport Access People (TAP) is a subsidiary company of Age UK Cornwall & The Isles of Scilly and **provides community transportation all around Cornwall, the Isles of Scilly and South Devon**.



TAP arranges transport for people who have non-emergency healthcare appointments, have difficulty accessing public transport, and for organisations and groups to attend social activities, such as memory groups, lunch clubs, shopping excursions and meeting friends.

Important Update on Eligibility Criteria

A number of people who are considered to be 'frequent users' of transport to and from Royal Cornwall Hospital Trust have recently received a letter from the NHS KCCG. This letter outlines **changes to the current eligibility criteria** that determine which patients are entitled to **free transport for non-emergency appointments**.

After receiving a **worrying number of calls into our Transport office**, it seems that people have had little to no warning, or were unaware of the **eligibility criteria changes**.

Anyone affected by these changes will be understandably anxious about how they will manage their **regular & one-off transport** for non-emergency appointments.

TAP and Age UK Cornwall & The Isles of Scilly are here to help with the practical issues, by offering our **voluntary car service** for individuals who require transport solutions.
