A few months ago, Falmouth Day Services applied to the National Lottery 'Awards for All' scheme for a grant to support an outreach & re-enablement project.

We are excited to announce that the application was successful and Falmouth Day Services has been awarded £10,000.

What is the funding for?

Falmouth will be recruiting an outreach & re-enablement worker to **reduce social isolation, assess the barriers that restrict individuals from engaging with the community, and provide guidance & signposting to improve an individuals' quality of life.**

Falmouth Day Services will be working with the community and liaising with local hospitals to develop person-centered plans for patients; **helping to build confidence, promote independence and greater choice.**

Our Day Centre, a wide range of activities and active signposting will be key in supporting early discharges and the often difficult transition from hospital to home.
