We know that our work does not stop here and one of our priorities is to **continue providing solutions as the world around us adapts**. Life is complex and it can be difficult to translate this experience into a single word or phrase to search. We have created our online Guided Conversation to bridge this gap.

Using questions that have been **tried and tested by our Community Helpline**, in as little as a few minutes, the Guided Conversation can help you to develop a holistic vision of your situation, and as a result, can generate suggestions of resources that are of **most relevance and likely to be of most help to you**.

In reality, little can beat a face-to-face conversation where you **feel listened to and valued.** However, with the cut and thrust of modern society this is not always possible. The Online Guided Conversation has been developed as **an alternative in an everchanging environment.**



Who is it for?

In-keeping with a nationwide change in the dynamic of healthcare delivery and increased appetite for person-centred care, the Guided Conversation is a tool that can be used either: **independently, in the company of a loved one or in the presence of a medical professional** to facilitate discussion and understanding around the topics that really matter to you. We are exploring several different ways to build the conversation, including our **work with GPs and Patient Participation Groups to develop unique approaches** that widen the conversation about health and wellbeing in core services and local communities.

The digital component adds to the value of the conversation by using the information discussed to suggest relevant and beneficial community resources that could be the right fit for you. By saving the suggestions to your profile and adding key ones to your favourites, you can choose to look back at your list at any time. When things change, you can simply log back in and change the most pertinent questions to generate suggestions that reflect your new circumstances.
