

Charging Point Statement

Driverenergy Ltd supplied the charging points that have been funded by the European Regional Development Fund and Age UK Cornwall to provide a resource specifically for charging the Age UK Cornwall Community Electric Vehicles across 6 sites in Cornwall. There has been no funding received from the UK government or their office of Low Emission Vehicles.

Each site has 2 charging points, to ensure that the Community vehicles can always access charging, even the event of a charging point fault, and to provide flexibility when a second vehicle is required on the site. It is not feasible to offer public access to the charging points as it may impact on the operation of the Age UK Cornwall scheme. The charging points are configured for access only by Members, Age UK Cornwall staff and volunteers.

It is not practicable to grant third parties' access to the charging points because this extends a duty of care and service responsibility to whoever will be using the charging points.
